2023 MLB DRAFT

Since its founding, the Nashua Silver Knights have had at least one player drafted in the Major League Baseball amateur draft each year. Coming into the 2023 season, the Silver Knights have had 33 former players selected in the MLB draft. The 2023 draft featured two more former Knights moving on to the next level, both members of the 2020 Championship team. Hunter Owen, a left handed pitcher out of Vanderbilt University was taken by the Kansas City Royals in the 4th round, and infielder Brady Day from Kansas State was selected by the Atlanta Braves in the 12th round. This brings Nashua's new total of drafted players to 35 over the team's 13 year history.





Awards

This season, the Silver Knights roster featured 8 Futures League All Star selections. Andrew Chenevert (Saint Anselm), Michael Gemma (Northeastern), Zach Gitschier (SNHU), Will Ray (Wake Forest), Will Fosberg (Northeastern), Jack McDermott (Amherst), Luca Giallongo (New England College), and Shane McNamara (Eastern Nazarene). Shane McNamara also completed in the Home Run Derby and finished runner up. McNamara also took home the Adam Keenan Award for sportsmanship, while Will Fosberg won the title of the league's Top Pro Prospect


